# RDA replaces AACR2

# RDA can be used with MARC but is structured to work with new data formats

## "Take what you see" in transcribed fields

# No more "rule of three" in the statement of responsibility

## Abbreviations are spelled out

## Terms such as "Jr." are now part of a name:

Williams, Hank, Jr., 1949-

[s.l.] : [s.n.] has been replaced by [Place of publication not identified]: [publisher not identified]

## The imprint has moved from field 260 to field 264

## While <u>publication</u> date appears in 264\$c, <u>copyright</u> date can appear in a separate 264\$c.

## The general material designator is replaced by:

- Field 336 Content Type
- Field 337 Media Type
- Field 338 Carrier Type

### Example for Electronic Resource

- 336 \$atext \$2rdacontent
- 337 \$acomputer \$2rdamedia
- 338 \$aonline resource \$2rdacarrier

### Two coded fields:

- 040 \$erda
- 008 Desc= i (for ISBD)

## The addition of Relationship Designators

Added to Ixx and 7xx fields
